Dear 6th District Homeowner:

On July 12, 2022 the City of Milwaukee Common Council approved funding from the Tax Incremental District (TID) No. 41, Time Warner Cable Riverwalk, for infrastructure improvements within one-half-mile of the District's boundaries.

These infrastructure improvements included, but are not limited to, traffic calming, street repaving, and pedestrian crosswalk pavement markings. Traffic calming type and locations were coordinated with Brewer's Hill representatives at the time of Council approval. The Department of Public Works evaluated all streets within the one-half-mile boundary, and roadways that were eligible for asphalt resurfacing were repaved and corner curb ramps updated to be ADA compliant. A map of the TID boundaries and mentioned infrastructure improvements is enclosed with this letter. Note, roadway repaving projects are called 'High Impact Paving Project' on the map.

Construction took place throughout 2023 and completed in 2024. 100% of the construction cost was paid by the TID, and there is no cost to adjacent property owners.


